52 – More About Maximum Glory

“Fear God and give glory to Him” (Revelation 14:7) The purpose of God in the plan of salvation is not just to save us, but to do it in a way to give Him maximum glory. Here are some positively practical ways in which we can give God maximum glory:

- We give God glory when we willingly confess our sins. Hidden and unconfessed sins cannot be forgiven, and God only receives glory for sins that have been forgiven.
- We give God glory when we accept salvation as a free gift. We dishonor Him when we try to work for what is a free gift.
- We give glory to God when we esteem the cross of Christ to be of highest value.
- We glorify God when we acknowledge our helplessness and allow Jesus to save us.
- We glorify God when we boast about His salvation and speak less about our own good works.
- We glorify God when we accept the offer of His Son Jesus Christ to be our advocate in the last judgment and trust that His righteousness is more than enough to cover all our sins.
- We glorify God when we trust His word, and we dishonor Him when we disbelieve Him.
- We glorify God when we seek to bring about unity (which is not always uniformity) between Christian believers in God's church. *“And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one”* (John 17:22).
- We glorify God when we do not run from and resist His love. He wants us to know the same kind of closeness, intimacy and unity that exists (and always has existed) between the Father and the Son.
- We glorify God when we soak ourselves in the unfathomable love of God realizing that there is nothing we can do to make God love us more

and there is nothing we can do to make God love us less. When we receive that love, God is glorified, for God is love!

- We glorify God when we praise Him continually for who He is and for what He has done at Calvary's cross for us. "*Whoever offers praise glorifies me*" (Psalm 50:23).

God is most glorified when we are most satisfied in Him!

When we are satisfied in Him, it is impossible for the temptations and deceptions of the enemy to allure us away from our position of joyous satisfaction in Him.

Our satisfaction and contentment in the redemptive work of the slain Lamb of God is the best protection against the worship of the beast.

How excellent is Thy lovingkindness, O God! therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Thy wings. They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of Thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of Thy pleasures. For with Thee is the fountain of life: in Thy light shall we see light. (Psalm 36:7-9).
